Descriptor(s):

HLTAID001: This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines.

This unit applies to all workers who may be required to provide CPR, in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

Specific licensing /regulatory requirements relating to this competency, including requirements for refresher training should be obtained from the relevant national/state/territory Work Health and Safety Regulatory Authorities.

UETTDRRF10B: This Competency Standard Unit covers the provision of first aid in an Electricity Supply Industry (ESI) environment. It includes the recognition and provision of an initial response where first aid is required in emergency situations by providing essential first aid using basic life support measures according to established workplace first aid policies and procedures.

Entry Requirements:

HLTAID001: Nil.

The prerequisite for UETTDRRF10B is HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the learner must be assessed as competent in the HLTAID001 component of this training before commencing the UETTDRRF10B component of this training.

Duration: Initial Training – 6 hours, Refresher – 3 hours

- Basic literacy, numeracy and writing skills are required.
